



BoilerMag Cleaning Frequency

How often do you clean your BoilerMag?

One of the selling features of BoilerMag is that there is very little pressure drop across the filter as the unit fills up with magnetite, unlike media type barrier filters. Measuring pressure differential is not always accurate. We have typically suggested a 1 day, 1 week, 1 month cleaning schedule after installation. The theory being that you first check it after a day to gauge how dirty the system is. If it is full of contamination, then clean it. Then check again after another day until it is no longer full. You can then extend to a week and so on as the system cleans up. If the first check after a day shows not much collection, then check again after a week, and then weekly until it can be done each month. Once you have a cleaner system then once per season is probably okay.

One thing we do see is that some BoilerMag users clean the magnet when they only have a small amount of contamination on the rods, which is more frequently than required. The magnets can hold a large amount of contamination and don't need cleaning when there is only a small film of collection.
